Usage


Add-on bar icon

The add-on bar icon that appears on the add-on bar:



A. Left-click


Left-click opens the search panel:




In order to perform a search you have to type the name (and / or the surname) you want in the textbox. When done hit the "**Enter**" key or click the "**Search**" button.

The results appear (**simultaneously**) in two ways:

1. Through a Custom Search Engine (CSE) at sffaddon.com/people-search that targets only the sites of interest. You can filter the results by site if you want to make the search more specific. Just click one of the labels that appear between the textbox and the results in order to do so.



2. As links pointing to the search pages of the social networking sites:



You can visit these pages by clicking on the icons (left, middle and right click will all do the job). You can hide the icons by clicking the "Clear" button.

Only 15 of the total 30 sites supported by the add-on appear as icons in the result panel. You can choose which of these 15 will show up after each search by setting the add-on's preferences as you wish.

If you haven't selected any sites in the preferences dialog the add-on bar icon appears in gray scale: 

In this case results appear only through the CSE on sffaddon.com and no icons show up in the search panel. Instead you get the message: "You have selected no sites!".


It is possible to hide the icon via the preferences dialog.

B. Middle-click

By middle-clicking the add-on bar icon you get forwarded to sffaddon.com/people-search where you can perform directly a new name search.

C. Right-click

The right-click reveals the add-on's menu.



- **Search Page** - You get forwarded to sffaddon.com/people-search where you can perform directly a new name search. The entry can be selected by pressing the key "S". You can also open the "Search Page" with the shortcut Ctrl+Shift+F
- **Options** - Opens the preferences dialog. While the menu is expanded the entry can be selected by pressing the key "O". This could be done in one step with the shortcut Ctrl+Shift+A
- **Documentation** - It opens in a new Firefox's tab the extension's documentation. While the menu is expanded the entry can be selected by pressing the key "D". The same action is available with the shortcut Ctrl+Shift+Z
- **Changelog** - Record of the changes made to SFF. You can access it by clicking the key "A" while this menu is open or always with the shortcut Ctrl+Shift+C
- **About SFF** - Shows the "about" window of the extension. The entry can be selected by pressing the key A.


The same menu can be accessed through Firefox's "**Tools**" menu.

Highlight a name you encountered in a webpage, right-click it in order to open the context menu and then select "**Search social networks**". That will perform a search for the highlighted name and the results will be shown through the CSE.


Search bar plug-in

Along with the add-on a search bar plug-in gets installed.



You can type a name in the search bar box and hit enter or click the magnifying glass icon in order to see the result on sffaddon.com/people-search.

Options



The preferences dialog makes possible to select which sites' icons will appear in the search panel during a search. It is possible to deselect all the icons if you want. In this case the add-on bar icon turns gray.

The option "Add-on bar icon" hides the add-on bar icon when deselected. In this case you can access the add-on through the shortcuts or via the "Tools" menu. You can activate again the add-on bar icon. That requires a browser restart.
